Tips for connecting with your community:

- 1. Don't aim for perfection!
- 2. Understand your community better by reaching out
- 3. Connect with people and communities in their safe spaces
- 4. Commit to growing and learning
- 5. Learn, listen and partner with people who are different
- 6. Agree shared goals and outcomes when working with others
- 7. Share what you learn with others

Top tips for inclusion and accessibility in your group:

- 1. Use a buddy system to help people feel welcome and included
- 2. Tell anyone who doesn't use English as their first language about our translated materials and language line
- 3. Personal welcome and check in with all members
- 4. Encourage members to feel ownership of the group
- 5. Use accessible venues, transport and communication resources suited to your members needs.
