


£7 million had been raised by the time of Deborah's death.

They've continued to test and introduce new fundraising products and offers to reach new audiences.




Earlier this year, the Omaze partnership raised a whopping £3,000,000 for the fund.




In 2025, 8 people will be running the London Marathon for the Bowelbabe Fund.
